Marilyn Minter was born in Shreveport, Louisiana and lives and works in New York City. She has been the subject of numerous solo exhibitions including at Regen Projects, Los Angeles, 2013; Deichtorhallen in Hamburg, Germany in 2011; the Museum of Contemporary Art, Cleveland, OH in 2010; La Conservera, Centro de Arte Contemporáneo Ceutí/Murcia, Spain in 2009; and the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art in 2005. Her video *Green Pink Caviar* was exhibited in the lobby of the MoMA for over a year, and was also shown on digital billboards on Sunset Boulevard in LA. In 2006 Marilyn Minter was included in the Whitney Biennial, and in collaboration with Creative Time she installed billboards all over Chelsea in New York City. Her work is currently featured in "Riotous Baroque", a group exhibition at the Guggenheim Bilbao through October 6, 2013. Minter teaches in the MFA department at the School of Visual Arts in New York.
